



KinderKids

KinderKids is a non-licensed, half-day recreational program for children 4 – 6 years old that helps to bridge the gap between Kindergarten school hours and the beginning or end of your work day. Our values-based program is a place where children can learn, play and grow.

KinderKids is offered Monday to Friday, your choice of 2, 3 or 5 days a week, with a morning or afternoon option. For the 2012-2013 school year, **KinderKids will take place at Woodroffe United Church, 207 Woodroffe Avenue.**

Morning option: 9:30 am - 12:15 pm
Afternoon option: 12:15 pm - 3:00 pm

Y Core Values

The following core values guide all the interactions in our program:

- Caring is accepting others. It is being compassionate, generous, sensitive and thoughtful.
- Honesty is shown through integrity, fairness and sincerity in words and deeds. It is being trustworthy and trustful.

YMCA-YWCA Staff

Our staff are selected for their competence, experience and enthusiasm. All staff are trained in Standard First Aid and CPR, YMCA Healthy Child Development, child guidance and more to ensure the best possible experience for your child. The KinderKids staff to child ratio is 1 to 10.

Refund and Withdrawal Policy

One month notice in writing is required to withdraw a child from the program. Notice that is less than one month will result in the processing of the next scheduled pre-authorized payment and no refund will be issued. Monthly fees are calculated based on the annual program divided by number of payments, therefore, fees will not fluctuate based on the number of care days. The Y reserves the right to cancel registration in the program due to outstanding payment of the monthly fees.

Food

Parents are required to provide healthy snacks and lunch for their children. Nuts or products containing nuts or nut oils are not permitted due to allergies.

Calendar

The program follows a three semester format:

- Fall (September to December)
- Winter (January to March)
- Spring (April to June)

The program begins the first full week of school in September and concludes on the last day of school in June. The program will not operate on statutory holidays and school PD days, Christmas and March Break, or school closures due to inclement weather.

Morning Pre-Care (8:15 am – 9:30 am) or Mid-Morning Pre-Care (11:00 am – 12:15 pm) provides care until the KinderKids program begins, as well as drop off/pick up of your child at Woodroffe Elementary School. An additional fee applies.
